Psalms 24

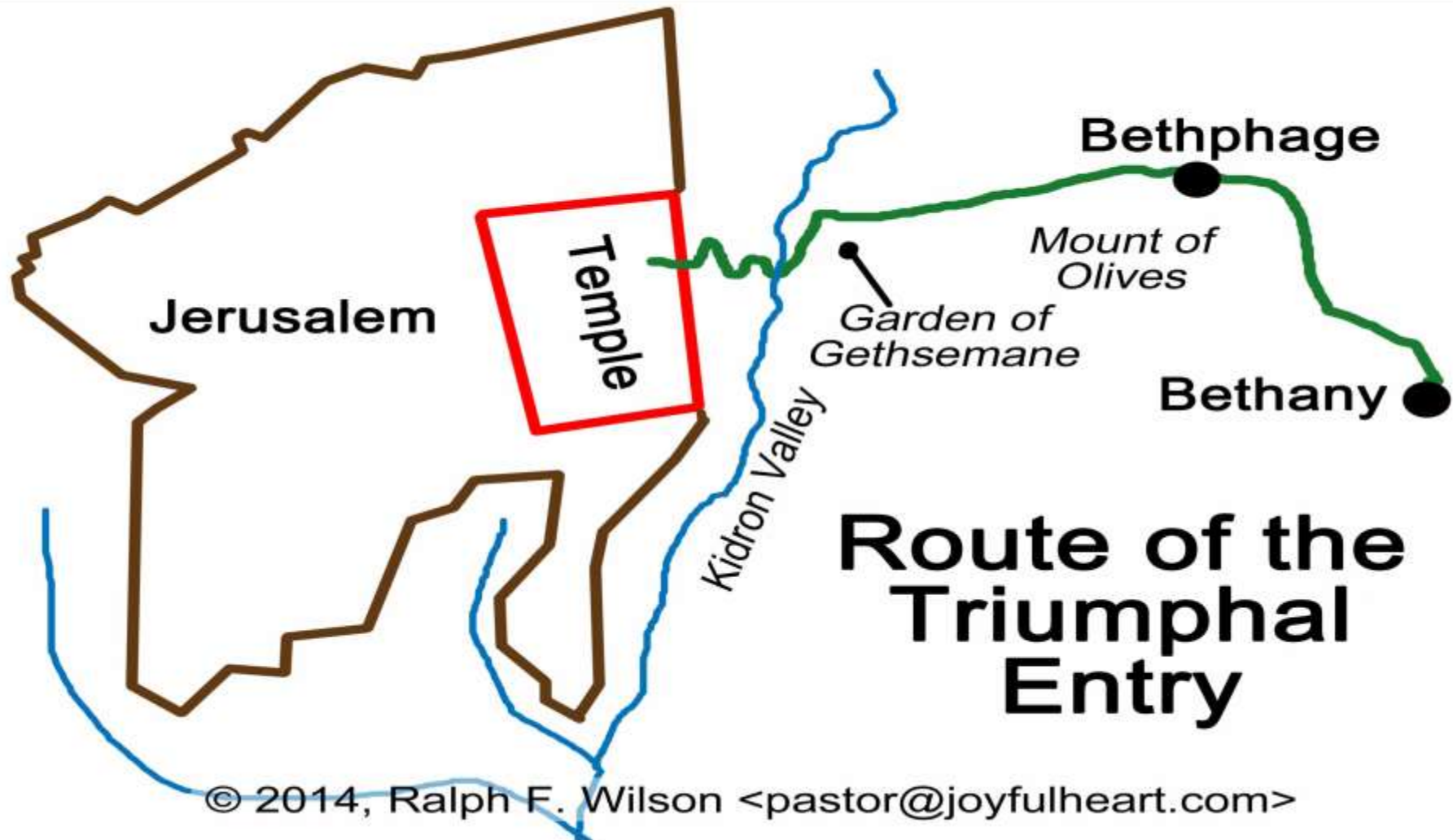
I Corinthians 3:16-23

I. Arrival as per the Prophecy

- Zechariah 9:9
- The Coming Ruler of God's People
- More than 500 years before
- After the completion of the Temple

Relevance of God's voice in our life

- Do we incline our ears to prophecies in the Bible?

II. Arrival to bring Peace

- Intention is to bring peace
- Donkey is a symbol of peace
- Vehicle of Kings during times of peace
- Not to conquer authority but heart

Relevance of Peace in our life

- Are we in peace with God, fellow-human and ourselves?

III. Arrival deserving Reverence

- Donkey was not allowed to touch the ground, but the cloaks
- Publicly Jesus appears as a King
- Crowd making the right arrangement
- Loud acclamations of “Hosanna”

Relevance of Reverence for God

- Do we revere God in our daily walks of life?


1 CORINTHIANS 3:10-11, 16-23
