Be empowered...

Are you on a Lenten fast? How's it going? Have you ever felt, "I shouldn't have taken this fast."? or have you felt that it was your baby step in getting closer to God? Most of the religions have fasting, but the *modus operandi* differs widely. Some people do it under dire pressure, and yet some do it out of free will. People are forced to fast for some medical tests too. What's your take on fasting? However you do fasting, the core purpose determines the impact and outcome of the great decision of giving up something so dear to you.

If we need to have an effective fasting, we must look at the rolemodel, Jesus Christ. He was very hungry and tired from a forty-day fast and was tempted by the devil. He faced the temptations boldly with the double-edged sword - the Word of God. Temptations are unavoidable. They lurk to pounce on us like the lion that lies in wait. The question is not how to be magical in avoiding them, but how to face them. Though Jesus was physically weak, His inner self gained more strength. His wits were cleared. The word of God became His refuge and fortress. When we are tempted, we might fall a prey to it as our outer and inner persons are weak. Jesus was also tempted, yet without sin. How much more should we learn and memorize the Word of God to be able to confront temptations! We must be able to say, "for it is written...". Our actions must also show the love of God. Isaiah 3:4 says, "Yet on the day of your fasting, you do as you please....", "You cannot fast as you do today, and expect your voice to be heard on high." Verses 6 to 8 call for action - to display God's love through helping those in need. Jesus showed us the love of God through His actions. "Then you will call, and the Lord will answer; you will cry for help, and he will say: Here am I." (Isaiah 3: 9)

During this lent, let the life of prayer empower us, the Word of God strengthen and fortify us, and the Spirit of God equip us for a powerful faith life.
