Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

St. Luke is considered to be a vigilant historian. He documented the birth of Jesus and

various incidents which were sensitive in the historical context of the Roman Empire. His writings highlight how Jesus was taken up to heaven in His resurrected body, in the presence of eleven of His apostles after 40 days of His resurrection, at the place called Bethany. St. Luke also highlights the event of Ascension with special emphasis on the existence of eyewitnesses "before their very eyes" (Acts 1:9).

The Ascension of resurrected Jesus has always been a mystery, for it is beyond the understanding of human senses and experiences. It takes us into the realms of the supernatural. The Ascension of the resurrected Jesus happened very plainly and swiftly after He gathered and delivered His farewell message to His disciples with the scriptural explanations. Then He lifted up His hands and blessed them. After that He raised Himself up supernaturally, and clouds covered him from the sights of all those gathered there (Luke 24:50).

Now the question to ponder on: Why did Lord Jesus stay on the earth for 40 days after His resurrection? During these 40 days, the resurrected Jesus met thousands of people in His resurrected body and strengthened them through healing and preaching. He also met His beloved disciples. These meetings confirmed the news about His resurrection and thereby removed their doubts about it. By His ascension many acknowledged His power and His authority. It was an act to revive many, physically and spiritually.

The Lord's Ascension, like Easter, is an important day to be celebrated. But majority of Christians failed to understand the importance of this day. Doubts and difficulties are common scenarios in our Christian life. We try to solve these issues by relying on our wisdom or we seek guidance and advices from others. These approaches will only worsen the issues and may instead lead to other problems.

The permanent solutions to all our problems can be sought from our Saviour and Lord Jesus Christ. For this, we need to have constant encounter with our Lord Jesus, which will strengthen us and give us enough courage to face these problems that confront us.

Lenten services, Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter worships have blessed us all. But sometimes, the participation of the church members was very low. I know, in the future worships, you will solve this problem.
