Achen's Message

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Christian Stewardship is an honorable designation. Psalm 24 teaches that the Earth and all in it belongs to God. Also, Genesis 2:15 states, "Then the Lord God took the man and put him into the Garden of Eden to cultivate it and keep it". Through these scriptures, it is clear that God has the "Ownership", and He assigned us the responsibility to develop and to supervise His creations, the expression of His glory. Volunteering at Salvation Army - March 30
