#### Report after reading Gospel of Matthew

During this summer, I was given a task to read the book of Matthew by Chris Achachan, and I began skimming through the book but I found this as a humbling experience. This is because as I kept reading, I learned to read in-between the lines and find deeper meaning within the verses. This was especially apparent during the many teachings early on in the book, which I had to stop and think about what more could this passage be referring to. To my surprise, there were a lot of instances where I couldn't come up with an explanation and that troubled me because I wasn't able to see the full truth behind it.

One thing that I picked up on was by how many parables there were throughout the book. Then I was curious to the reason why Jesus even used parables to convey messages. Jesus used parables to convey his messages because of the type of audience he had, ordinary people who at the time period most likely were not educated instead focusing on work and using parables about their daily life is a more effective way to connect with them.

One of the parables that stood out to me was the one about the lost sheep, where even if a single sheep strays away, the shepherd will leave ninety-nine of the sheep behind in search for the lost one. This parable stood out to me because of how it showed God's willingness to search for you and save each and every one of us even if you stray away from him.

One thing I was taken aback by was reading the calling of Matthew. Jesus saw Matthew and simply said to follow him, and without any hesitation Matthew began following him. During that time period tax collectors were considered to be sinners, then when the Pharisees inquired about this Jesus replied that a doctor is needed for the sick, not for the healthy. In other words, Jesus was saying he was calling the people who were suffering and needed help not the ones who were fine. This reassures that everyone has been called for a place in the Kingdom of God even if you lead a sinful life.

Another important thing I learned was about the Lord's prayer, which all of us pray on a daily basis. In this prayer, Jesus gives us an example of how a prayer should be by summarizing your requests and showing thankfulness into a quick prayer. This prayer also addresses God as a father and not as a divine being.

After this reading experience I have come to the conclusion that the book of Matthew is an important part of the Bible that is deeply rooted in our daily lives.
