Shall we not raise our voices and sing with the psalmist, "I'll praise thee; for I'm fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well."

Achen's Message



Dearly beloved in Christ,

Greetings in the matchless name of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ.

As we enter another month let us praise and thank God for all his blessings in the past and let us pray for his mercy in our journey ahead.

We observe youth Sunday and reformation Sunday in the month of October. Also, we are having Thanksgiving Day and our harvest festival in this month. We are living in a modernized, technologically advanced, science-based world and our youths are the primary beneficiaries of all these advancements. So, the danger is the possibility of shifting from Christ centered/faith centered life to a pleasure centered life. So, it is the time for us to determine the boundaries for our engagement and develop a new lifestyle which will keep the youth as disciples of that great master Jesus. I praise God for our youth fellowship and congratulate all their efforts that enrich our church life.

The last Sunday in October we observe as Reformation Sunday, which commemorates the Protestant Reformation as well as Martin Luther. It was movement against the corruption and other evil practices existed in the Catholic church. If a person – out of contrition for their sins and as a sign of repentance – made a financial gift to help with the building Saint Peter's Basilica in Rome, then the church would furnish that person with a certificate acknowledging that gift and promising that they or their loved ones would be freed from a portion of the misery expected in the afterlife. In short, the church at that time taught that even those bound for heaven had to be cleansed of their earthly sins and this cleansing (purging) in the afterlife took place in a place called Purgatory. The certificates offered by the church (called "Indulgences") promised to lessen this time of cleansing for oneself or others who have already died. November 1st was an important day for the selling and buying of these indulgences, known as All Saints Day on the church's calendar. The day before Martin Luther posted a list of 95 Theses – 95 reasons that he objected to this practice of selling indulgences. Along with other writings by Martin Luther, those 95 Reasons went viral. Luther insisted that we are not forgiven because of anything we do like buying of Indulgences. Instead, we are forgiven because of who God is. We are loved and forgiven because God is full of grace and mercy. Luther and his followers expelled from the church that marked the beginning of protestant churches. Every Protestant church including CSI traces their roots back to this moment in history.

I request the prayer and support of all the families for our Harvest festival on October 16. After two years we as CSI Toronto Church family gathering for the Harvest festival. let us come together and thank God for sustaining us in these years. And you all know it is the major source of our income. Let us pray and work together to make this year's harvest festival a grand success.
