#### **Editorial**

Just believe!

February is usually the month that Lent begins in the Church calendar. It is well placed that way as we typically have fewer distractions here at this time of the year; being in the deep of winter, with Christmas behind us and Spring still weeks away. However, what we often see as Lent approaches is deliberation on what to give up; whether it be some types of food, or other things. As we approach Lent this year let's consider what motivates us to do this. Are we doing it for our own satisfaction, or is it an act of obedience and discipline to foster spiritual growth?

If we look at the example of Christ, He was isolated and went without food for forty days in the wilderness, and at the end of that time He used the Word of God to face temptation. This example suggests to us that true value in self denial is only where the outcome is focussed on growing closer to the Lord. Interestingly though, as human beings we like to feel that our efforts contribute in some way to the spiritual and material blessings we receive. Sometimes we have a hard time even accepting that salvation is God's free gift requiring nothing from us except to believe. This is too simplistic for some of us to accept, and we would rather be asked to embark on an arduous pilgrimage or such, so we can justify our worthiness to be saved. I would contend that if we're honest with ourselves we will recognize that this type of thinking is nothing but our pride at work.

The fact is that our greatest efforts can never compare with or add to Christ's sacrifice of Himself on the cross. So this Lent season let's learn to practice the simple faith of believing in Christ and learning His Word. And as it is said let us also remind ourselves that Salvation is free to us, but it is not cheap; it cost Jesus His life!

## Achen's Message



Greetings to all in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ!


We are entering into another season of Lent, the most important season in the church calendar. In our tradition, Lent is a season of forty days; seven weeks excluding Sundays; beginning on Ash Wednesday and ending on the Saturday before Easter. The Sundays in this season represent a "mini Easter", and so Sundays are for the celebration of the life of Christ. The forty days of Lent represent the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin His ministry. So the Lenten season reminds us again to fast and pray as our Savior Jesus did. Practicing this will greatly help each one of us to have victory over trials and temptations.

The word Lent comes from the Anglo Saxon word 'lencten' which means 'spring'. Spring is a life rejuvenating season, and in the same way Lent is also intended to be a time of self reflection, repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of the Lord. It is also a time of examining our relationships; the three aspects of our relationship with self, with God and with our surroundings.

In early church, Lent was a time of devoted study as they prepared new converts for Baptism. Lent was a time of giving up something or volunteering to give of oneself for the benefit of others. Lent is a time to open our hearts a little wider and to understand our Lord a little deeper; it's an opportunity to receive the overflowing grace of our Lord. It's also an opportunity to contemplate what our Lord really did for us on the Cross. Lent does not stop at sadness and despair with the death of Jesus; instead it points us to the hope of resurrection and the day when tears will be wiped away.

So let us come together and examine ourselves; assess how we were in the past in our relationship with God and our fellow beings. Let us be open to understand our short comings, let us abstain from actions that hurt our brethren, and let us come together and pray for His grace. Let us deny our 'SELF' and commit ourselves to the establishment of His kingdom. May this season of Lent be a great time of the Lord's abundant blessings upon us.
