As we are entering into a new month, let us ask for His guidance and blessings. In this month we are focusing on post resurrection thoughts as per our church calendar. Let us thank God for the incarnation, crucifixion and resurrection of the Son of God for all of us. Let us experience the presence of the risen Lord in our daily affairs and let us commit ourselves unto His hands for His mighty plan and purpose. His presence in our lives will empower us to go beyond the boundaries to love and serve His creation.

After the death of their Master the disciples were hiding behind locked doors because of fear of the Jewish leaders who had just crucified their Lord. It was not far-fetched to think that they might be next. They may have been discussing how they could sneak out of Jerusalem without being arrested. Suddenly, with no knock at the door or no one opening the door, the risen Lord Jesus stood in their midst saying "Peace be with you". John 20:20 reports the outcome after Jesus showed them His hands and His side by stating that, "The disciples then rejoiced when they saw the Lord."
