Editorial

Fruitfulness!

It is interesting that our church almanac recognizes students and seniors in the month of September. While this may seem like a contrast, it offers the important perspective that good character and values are moulded as we progress through the stages of student life into adulthood, and that fruitfulness is key quality to develop and sustain. The Bible seems to suggest this connection by reminding parents that if we, "Train up a child in the way he should go: when he is old, he will not depart from it" (Prov. 22:6). In similar vein, renowned poet William Wordsworth wrote that, "The child is the father of the man" (in his 1802 poem "My Heart Leaps Up"). This can be both an encouraging and an alarming thought.

As parents we all want our children to be successful and we invest much time and effort in planning academic pathways for them. There is nothing wrong with that as such, but it is estimated that over 50% of the jobs of the future haven't been invented yet. This should be a sobering thought for us parents to not think of ourselves as career development experts! Church VBS 2023: A Recap of the Babylon - Daniel's Courage in Captivity Theme
