

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Editorial

What we do not see!

Many of us have heard about the great redwoods and sequoia trees, and some of us may have the opportunity to see them in our lifetime. I had that opportunity recently, but nothing I had read or seen in pictures before prepared me for the wonder of standing close to them! Particularly stunning was the General Sherman Tree which owns the title of being the largest living tree and also the largest living organism on the planet!

What is striking about these majestic trees is that their girth and longevity come from the part that we do not see; a web of strong roots spanning an acre in width, 12-14 feet deep into the ground firmly rooting the tree through its almost 3,000-year lifespan. As people we are the same, in that, it is the parts of us that no one sees which make us who we really are. The Bible tells us that once we know Jesus our life is "hidden with Christ in God" (Colossians 3:3), meaning that we have died with Christ to sin and are spiritually awakened to new life. But we live in a broken society ruled by money and plagued with many social evils, where we may feel forced to hide our roots of family values and spiritual convictions in order to be politically correct in different situations. Sadly, we do this to our own detriment as Christians.

We are called to live boldly, building our character on God's Word, and living in accordance with Christ's example; fundamentally His simplicity and being conscious of the needs of others. We cannot hide that truth and intentionally choose to live with mean motives, or pleasing the world, or in social isolation, or disharmony with our family. If we do that, I doubt that our lives will be fruitful, for if we truly have Christ's spirit hidden in us, then everything we do outwardly should reflect His character.

As we approach another season of Lent, I hope we will take some time to objectively introspect what our lives and actions truly reveal about ourselves. May we find that we are rooted and grounded in Christ and so can stand tall and flourish like the mighty redwoods regardless of the circumstances around us.
